**1970:** Betty Friedan leads NYC march celebrating the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the day the 19<sup>th</sup> Amendment became an official part of the U.S. Constitution. The next year, at the urging of Bella Abzug, Congress named Aug 26 "Women's Equality Day."



**2010:** WomenArts creates new logo honoring 90<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the 19<sup>th</sup> Amendment. Logo is based on the "Bugler Girl" created by Caroline Watts in 1908 (widely acknowledged as the suffrage movement's best-known & most compelling imagery).
